SCHOOL OF ARTS AND HUMANITIES

Course Additions:

LIBS 480 Seminar Facilitation Units: 1-3
Grade Mode: Graded

This course provides students with an opportunity to enhance their facilitation skills through serving as a seminar leader in large lecture/discussion courses. Requires consent of course instructor.

Justification: For teacher's aids helping to facilitate discussion groups in large lecture courses.

THAR 420A Advanced Drama Block

Change Title: To: Advanced Acting Block

SCHOOL OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

Course Changes:

ENSP 442 Methods/Models in Educ. Environment

Delete Prerequisite: ENSP 440 or consent.

Justification: This requisite is preventing students from registering for this course.

GLBL 498 Cross-Cultural Community Service Internship

Change Course Number: From 498 to 497

Justification: Current numbering is creating registration errors.

GLBL 499 Capstone Seminar

Change Course Number: From 499 to 498

Justification: Current numbering is creating registration error.

SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Course Changes:

GEOL 410 Geophysics

Change Units: From 3 to 4.

Justification: Change from 2 units of lecture and 1 unit of lab to 3 units lecture and 1 unit lab is necessary to adequately cover the course content at the upper division level to reflect changes in the discipline. Course goes from 3 to 4 units for students.

Course Additions:

UNIV 236 Choosing a Major

Units: 1

Grade Mode: Graded or CR/NC

Begin to explore and discover values, skills, interests, and lifestyle preferences related to choosing an academic major. Special focus for freshmen and sophomores. Letter grade or CR/NC.

Justification: To provide an organized course with experiences for lower division students to explore their interests and preferences with the goal of choosing an academic major
