

## **SSU Student Health Center Summer Services**

*are in effect from the end of each Spring Semester  
to the start of each Fall Semester*

### **Basic Eligibility for Summer Services is as follows:**

**Students enrolled in academic summer session** pay required summer registration & health fees & receive free & low-cost summer health services similar to academic year services for enrolled students.

**Continuing SSU students** who were regularly enrolled during the spring semester and are enrolled for the coming fall semester, but are not enrolled in summer session may receive summer health services on a user fee basis paid at the time of each service (Continuing students may elect to pre-pay the summer session health fee amount (typically paid at registration by summer session students) directly to the SHC, by their 2nd summer visit. Pre paying the summer session health fee amount entitles the continuing student to free & low-cost summer health services similar to academic year services).

**Entering SSU students for the coming Fall Semester** may get **required immunizations & athletic clearance physicals** on a user fee basis once they've sent in their Enrollment Reservation Deposit (ERD) to SSU. (They may also be eligible for user fee based acute care during participation in summer orientation, NCAA athletic practice, or similar campus sponsored programs, or during the two weeks immediately prior to the start of their first semester. User fees are due at the time of each service.

### **Description of Summer Services:**

**A Nurse Practitioner &/or Physician** will be scheduled to be on site all or part of regular campus workdays during the summer. **Call in 707 664-2921 in advance for an appointment.**

**Appointments are offered at certain times only.** Drop-ins who don't have appointments may not be readily accommodated, depending on staffing & the needs of other patients.

Patients must be prepared to seek urgent medical care off campus if a SHC MD or NP is not immediately available - or if the care needed is beyond the scope of SHC services or its hours of operation. As is the case during the regular academic year, **off-campus healthcare is the financial responsibility of the patient.**

**Pharmacy:** Refills for previously prescribed medications expire at the end of the spring semester. Although the Pharmacy is open during much of the summer, it is typically closed from mid July to mid August. Appropriate but limited quantities of essential low-cost prescribed medication can be dispensed from the clinical area during that time **in conjunction with MD or NP visits only.** SHC prescriptions may also be filled at off campus pharmacies at patient expense.

**Lab & X-ray** - Some internal lab services &/or referral to an off-site lab & off site x-rays are available in conjunction with summer medical visits.
